Why not make the most of your visit to Liverpool by delving into the culture and history of the city?

Exploring all that the city has to offer starts at the conference, situated within the famous Albert and Kings Docks on Liverpool's Waterfront. Whether you are a culture vulture, music fanatic, ravenous foodie or retail queen, Liverpool will not disappoint. With the largest collection of museums and galleries anywhere outside of London, the city's culture and heritage is at the very heart of the city. If you are planning an extended visit, Liverpool Biennial 2014: The UK Biennial of Contemporary Art event is running before, during and after the conference with International art unfolding across Liverpool's spaces, places and galleries. At Liverpool's beautiful Philharmonic Hall, the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra's 'Classical Music Goes to the Movies' event is also running.

The non-negotiable legacy of Liverpool's music scene originates from their famous offspring, The Beatles. Situated close to the conference venue is The Beatles Story, an exhibition showcasing their musical journey. If you would prefer an after conference drink, the Cavern Club is Liverpool's top venue, a firm favourite of The Beatles themselves in the 1960's.

Liverpool has a wide range of restaurants available, benefiting from a selection of local produce ranging from the Claremont Farm asparagus, Wirral watercress to Knowsley lamb and Southport shrimps.

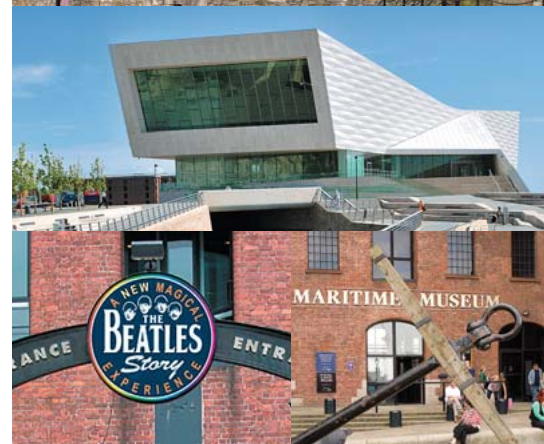
If you would prefer to escape the bright lights of the city, then head across to Knowsley, one of the city region's hidden gems just 8 miles from the city centre. The grand Knowsley Hall, a private residence in the 19th Early of Derby, is home to the Knowsley Safari Park and a fantastic on-site Spa.
